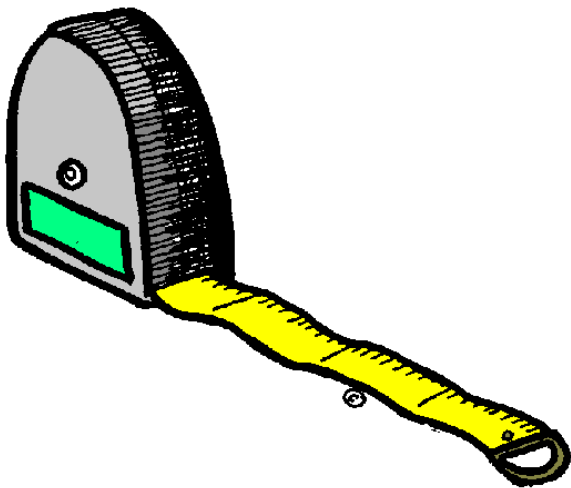

# Spell it by **knowing the rule**



**SPELLING RULE ONE**

When a word ends with a **short vowel** followed by a **consonant**, double the last consonant before adding 'ed'



The girls skip.                      The girls skipped.

drop	→	dro <u>pped</u>	trim	→	trim <u>med</u>
admit	→	admit <u>ted</u>	shop	→	shop <u>ped</u>
occur	→	occur <u>red</u>	flip	→	flip <u>ped</u>
